

Business Networking Events at Testwood School February 2023-Year 8



Pupil survey outcomes:

- 1. 91% of pupils learnt about job types / careers that they didn't know about.
- 2. 96% have an understanding of how workplaces are structured and the different roles people play.
- 3. 66% would consider a career in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts or Maths.
- 4. 27% would change their mind about a future career based on this experience.



Covid restriction question; 46% believe Covid impacted on the school careers programme, meeting employers or going on careers visits.
