




Business Networking Events at Testwood School January 2024- Year 10



Pupil survey outcomes:

1. **96%** of pupils learnt about job types / careers that they didn't know about.
 2. **99%** have an understanding of how workplaces are structured and the different roles people play.
 3. **59.5%** would consider a career in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts or Maths.
 4. **24%** would change their mind about a future career based on this experience.
