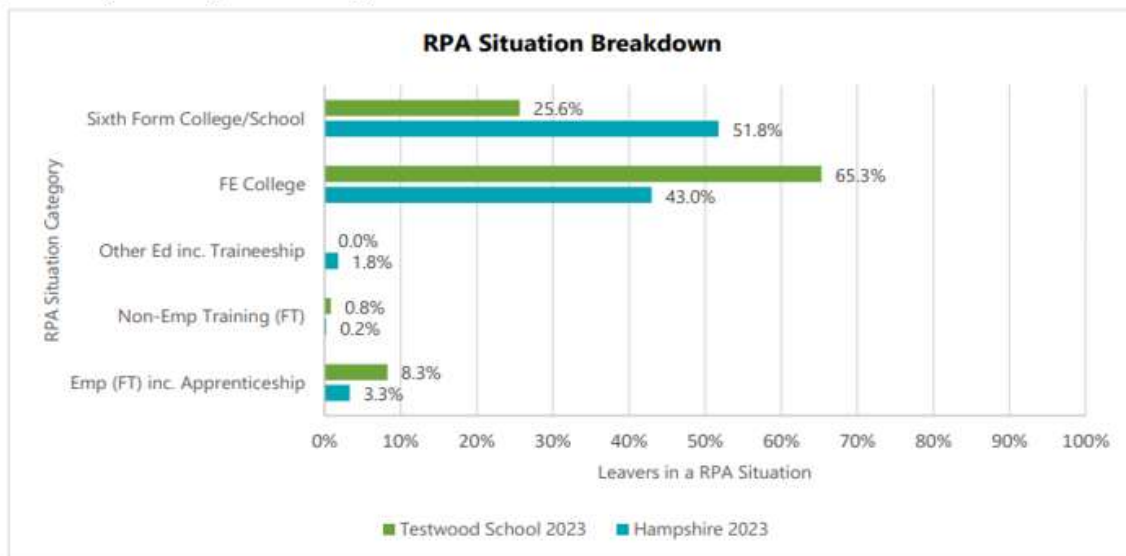


Destination Data at Testwood School 2023

RPA Situation Breakdown

RPA situations are grouped into five categories, seen below. The Situation Category table in the glossary on page 5 defines each category. The graph below shows that there is a smaller percentage of Testwood School leavers moving to an education programme ('Sixth Form College/School', 'FE College', 'Other Ed inc. Traineeship') than the Hampshire average, but a larger percentage moving to a training situation.



The tables below show the actual numbers of young people in each RPA situation. Where fewer than five people are recorded the information is withheld and replaced with '-'.

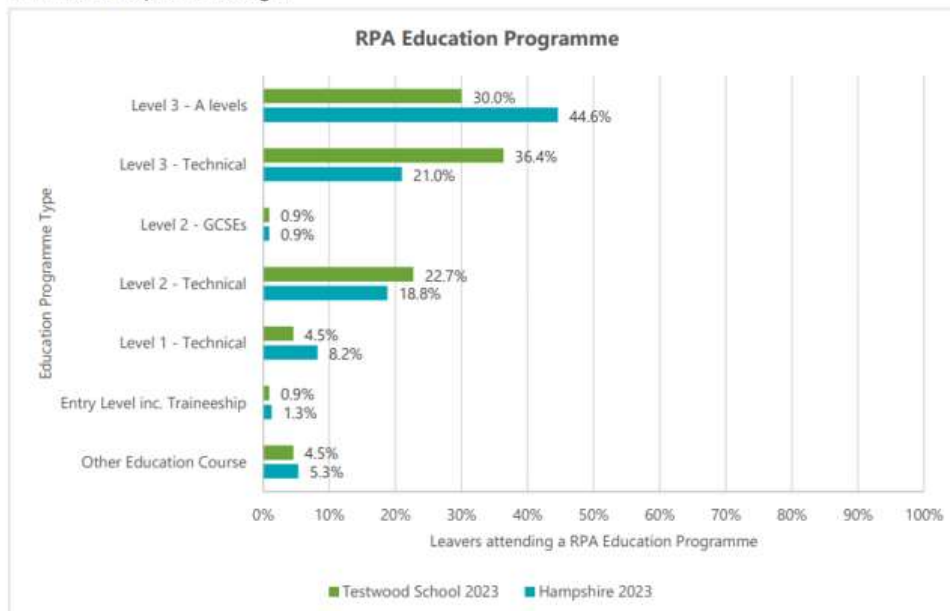

Our destination data shows consistently low number of learners become NEET (Not in Employment, Education or Training).

RPA Education Programme

There are different types of education programmes. The bar chart below shows that a higher percentage of education programme leavers from Testwood School moved on to study a Level 3 programme than the Hampshire average. A higher percentage moved to Technical programmes than the Hampshire average.



RPA Programme Establishments

Certain factors can greatly influence the appeal of a post-16 education establishment, such as the type of courses offered.

The table below shows the most popular establishments attended, as of 1st November 2023, by the Year 11 leavers from Testwood School who moved to a full-time education programme. It shows the number of young people attending the establishment, and the percentage they represent compared to all Testwood School full-time education leavers (110).

The figures include young people repeating a year of statutory education. Establishments with fewer than five people attending are not shown.

Year 11 leavers from Testwood School moving to an education programme also attended Sparsholt College, and Southampton City College.
