## Transition Days Key Information



**Dates:** Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> and Friday 4<sup>th</sup> July

**Arrival:** From 8.20am onwards (via Student Gate)

**Assembly Start time:** 8.30am

**Finish Time:** 2.45pm

**Clothing:** Students should wear their primary school PE kits on both days. Please look at the weather for the day and consider layers/coats if needed or alternatively a sun hat and sunscreen.

**Packed lunches will be provided on both days. Please pack a water bottle for your child and additional snacks should they want it.**

**Equipment:** Your child will need a pen, pencil, ruler and rubber for the day. They do not need a full pencil case with all the equipment you child's tutor discussed. They will need a full pencil case for September.

Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> July



**On Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> July**, please could all children go to the Main Hall by 8.30am.

They will be able to enter the school site via the Pupil Entrance (which is the gate on the left as you look at the school) and they will be welcomed by teachers and shown where they need to go by the Prefect Team.

All the children will be sat in their tutor groups and then Mr Webber and Mr Jenkins will deliver a short assembly, explaining what will be happening over the two days.

They will then have an extended tutor period and then the opportunity to complete a carousel of activities linked to; Art, Drama, Music and PE within their tutor groups. This will be led by our staff, excellent subject captains and prefects. After lunch, they will have a Maths lesson.

Each tutor group will be supported by prefects throughout the day and they will be shown which rooms to go to and supported in lessons by our excellent prefects.

To finish off the day all students will be a part of a final celebration assembly.

Again, students will finish at 2.45pm they will be escorted to the Pupil Entrance by their teachers and prefects. They will then be able to be collected or to walk home.
