





- Unsafe and dangerous behaviour


This could be in the form of:

Attendance





- Children are encouraged to be in school daily by no later than 8.20am in preparation for a 8.30am start to the school day
- ☐ Children are set an attendance target of 100% when they arrive in Year 7.
- If your child's attendance drops significantly below this figure then Tutor, Head of Year, Mrs Canning or Mrs Pinn (Attendance Officers) will be in contact to discuss.

Absence Procedure



Child absence due to illness

 Phone through to the front office and inform the school before 9.00am that your child will be absent or email <u>absence@testwoodschool.co.uk</u>

Child absence due to medical

 If your child needs to attend a medical appointment then please inform the school via the original appointment letter, a note or phone call. Where possible make appointments outside school hours.

Request for leave of absence

 This can only be granted in exceptional circumstances by Mr Webber (Head Teacher)
